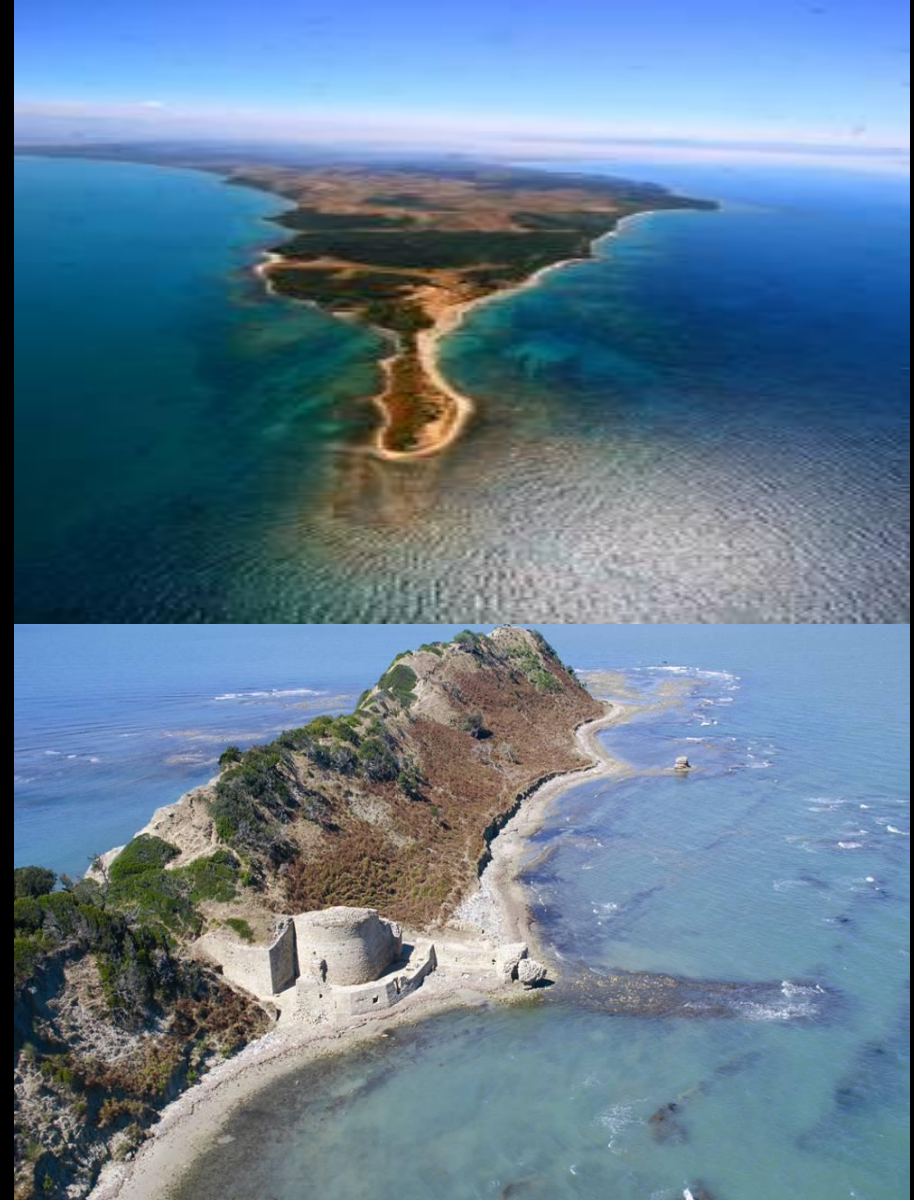
# Sazani Island

- Sazan Island is the largest island in Albania and also the country's westernmost point. It is located at the informal junction line of the Adriatic and Ionian Sea.
- The island has a length of 4.8 km and a width of 2.7 km, with a surface area of 5.7 km<sup>2</sup>, and 15 km coastal line. Land is state owned.



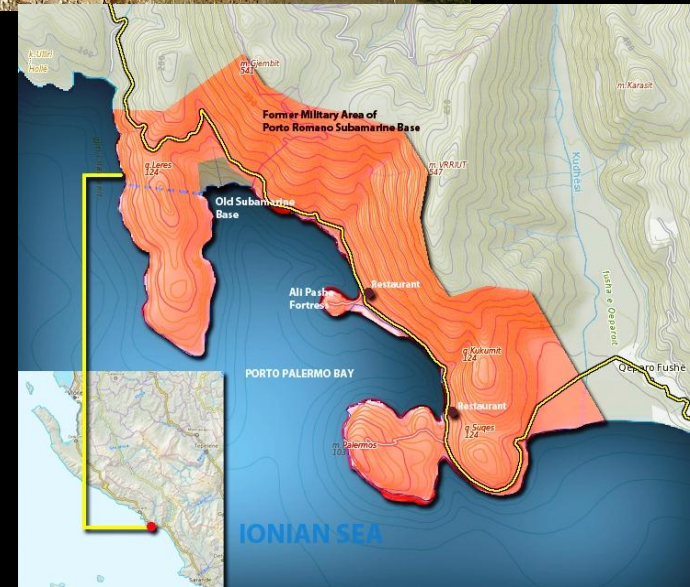
# Rodoni Cape

- Rodoni Cape, which includes this wetland area, starts north of the mouth of Drini river and ends south at the basis of Rodoni cape.
- The coastline is about 8 km long. The northern part (6 km) of the area is located in the District of Laçi and the southern part (2 km) in the District of Durrësi. Patok lagoon is comprised in the Fushe-Kuqe commune.



# Porto Palermo

- The area of Porto Palermo, within the Municipality of Himara, is one of Albania's areas of outstanding natural beauty
- The unique form of this site, with its history, ancient bay, modern naval submarine pens and special marine ecology offers the possibility of creating a rich multi-purpose development, including museum, maritime port, diving centre and panoramic vistas



# Karaburini Peninsula

- Karaburuni is the largest peninsula in Albania, about 62 km<sup>2</sup>. Situated in the south-west of the country it lies between the bay of Vlora on the east and the Ionian Sea in the west. Karaburun stretches for 16 km and a width of 3 to 5 km.
- The Karaburuni coastline is about 70 km and includes the coastal segment Orikum-Palasë.
- Landscape offers the most varied forms as small bays, plateau, karts caves, tertiary, beaches, bare slopes, mountains, etc.
