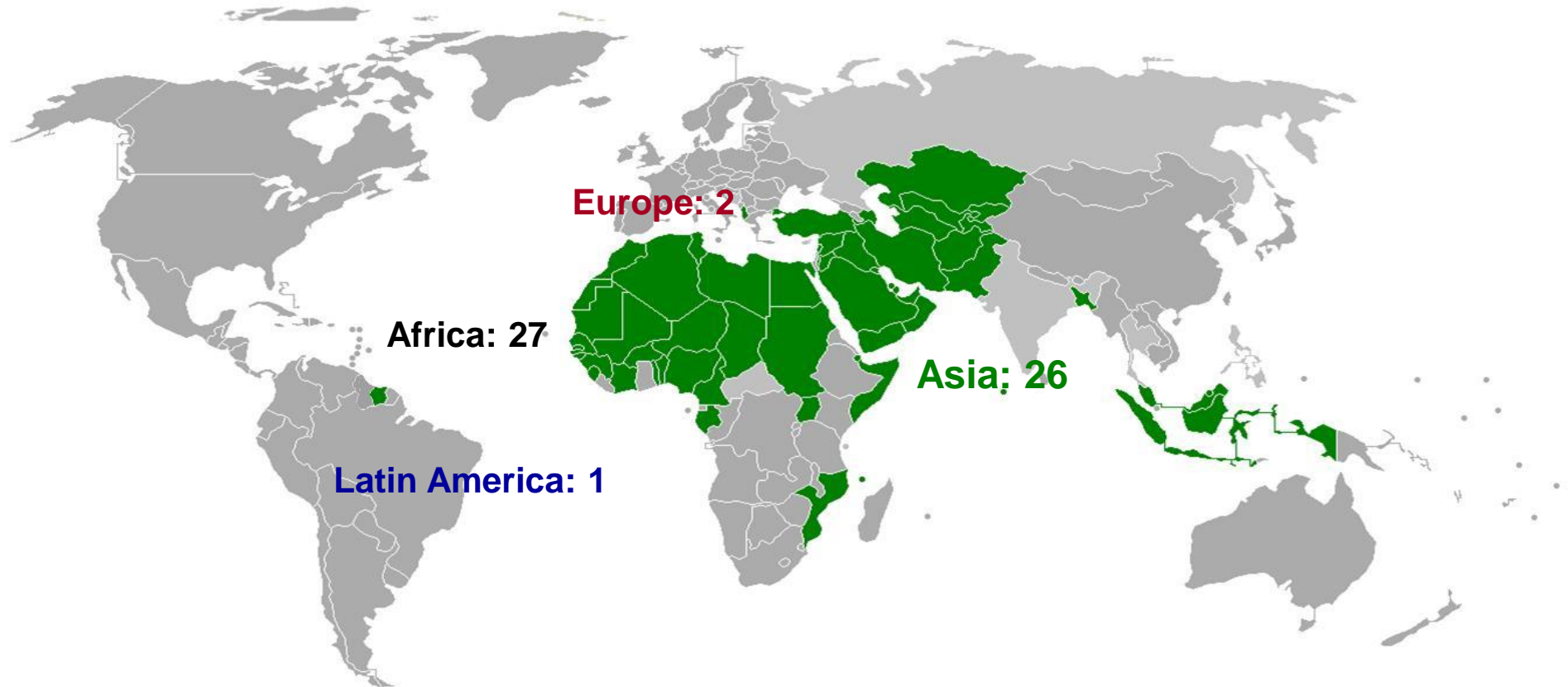

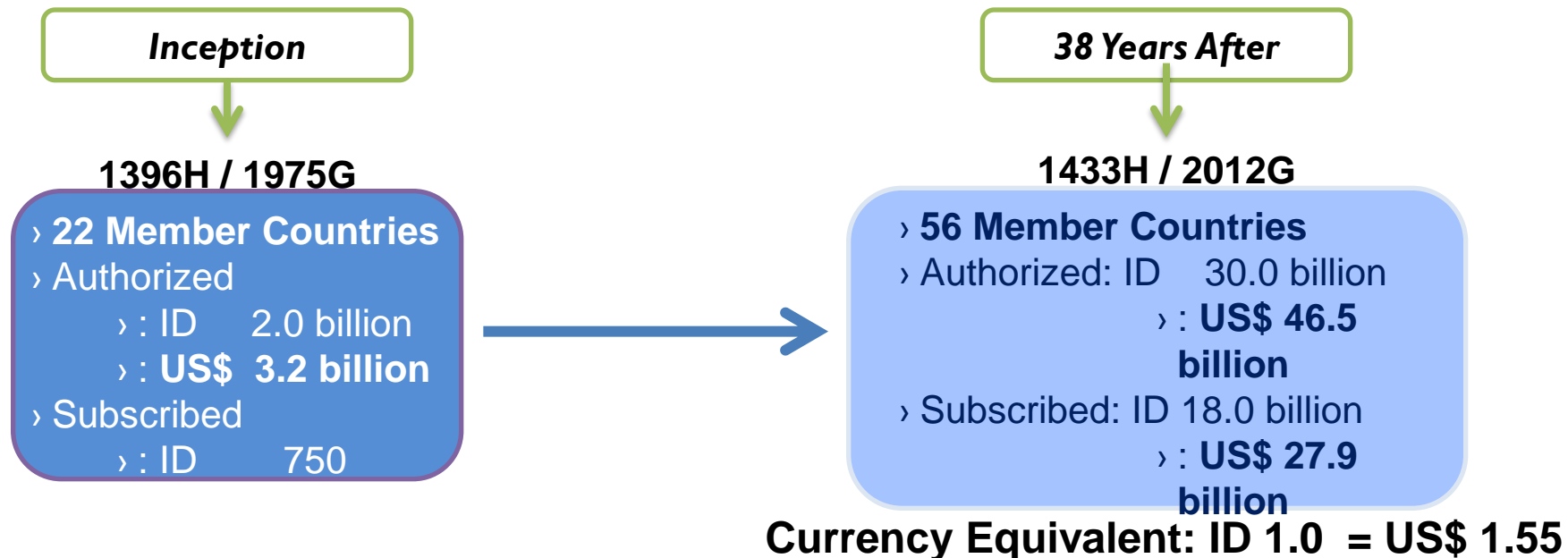

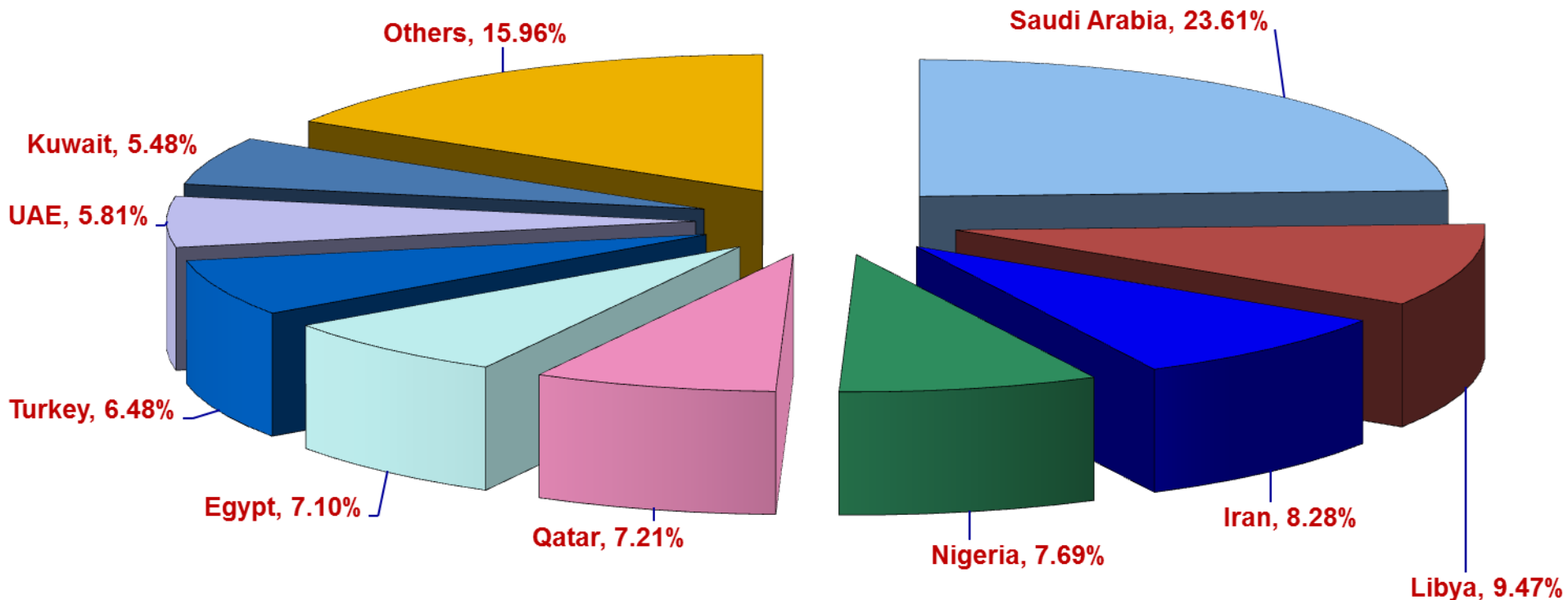
The Bank's mandate is to promote, comprehensive human development in the Muslim World

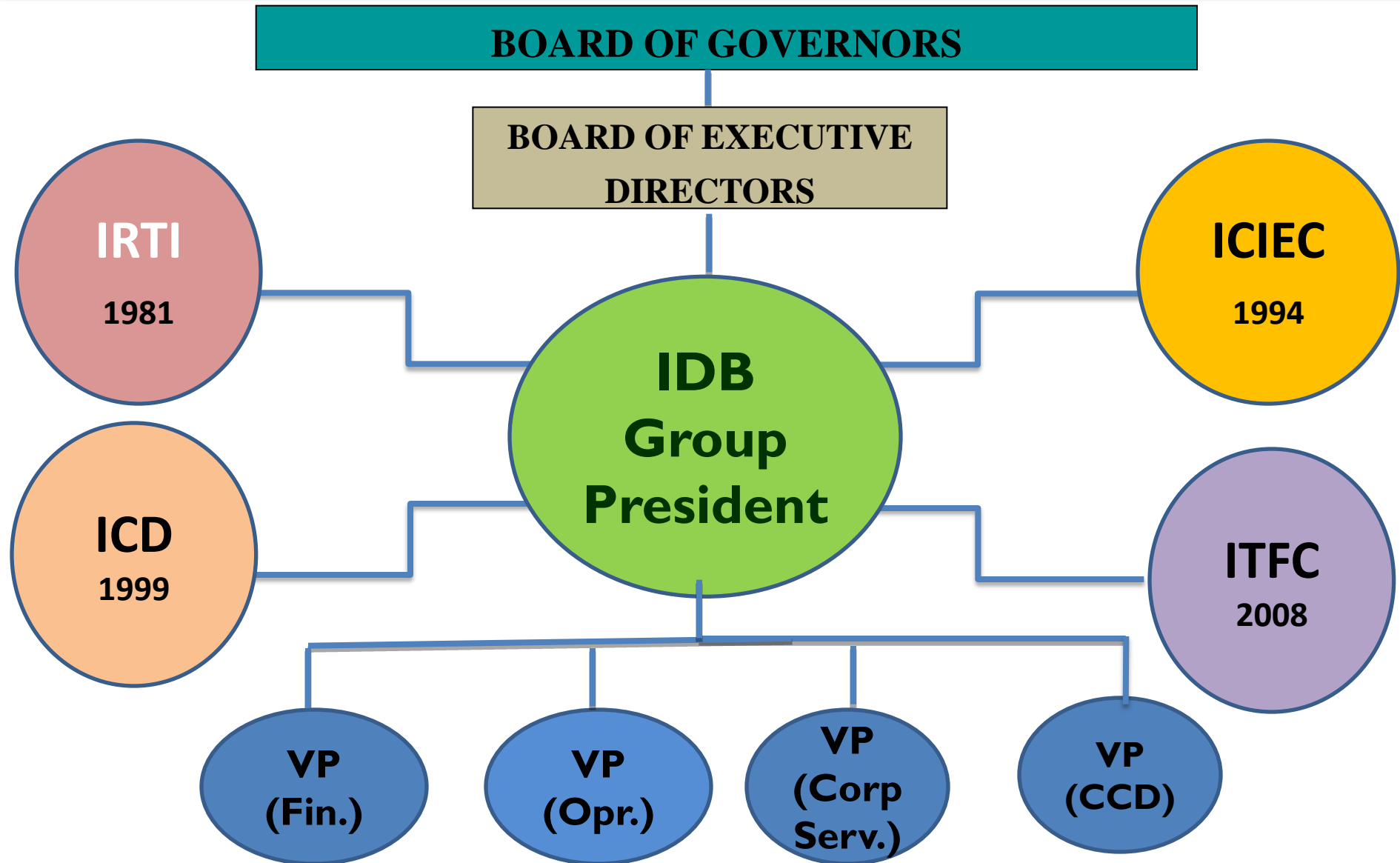

- ▷ Promote entrepreneurship, and encourage cross- country investments.



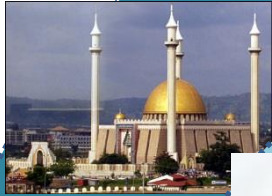

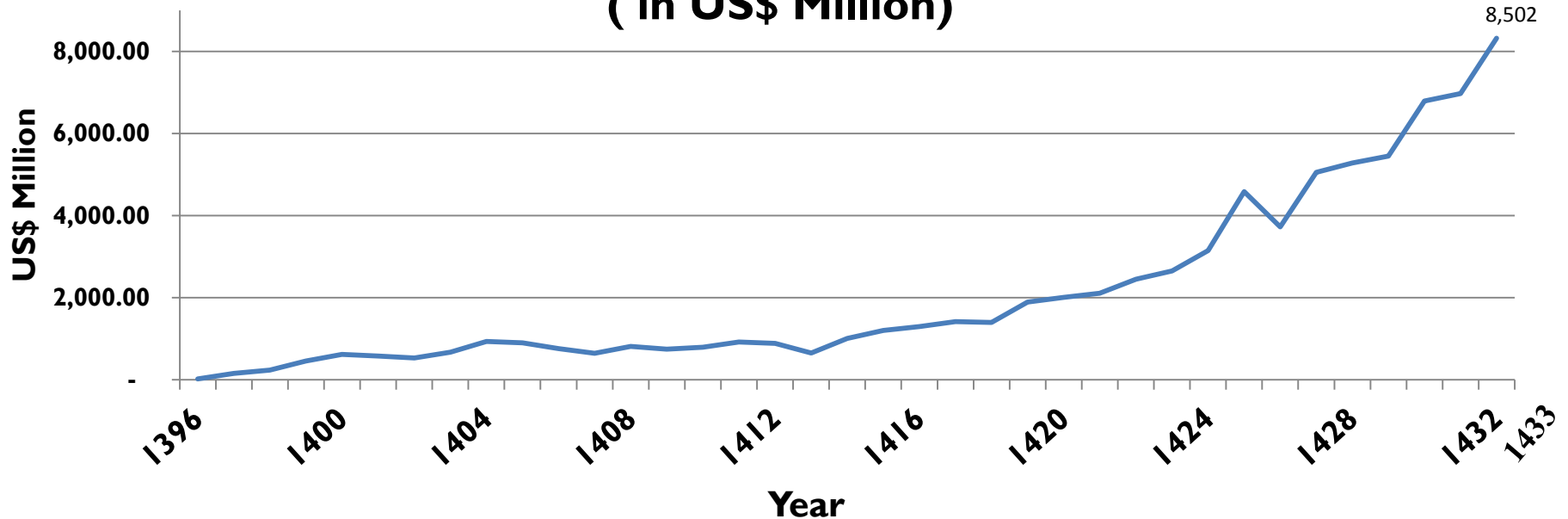

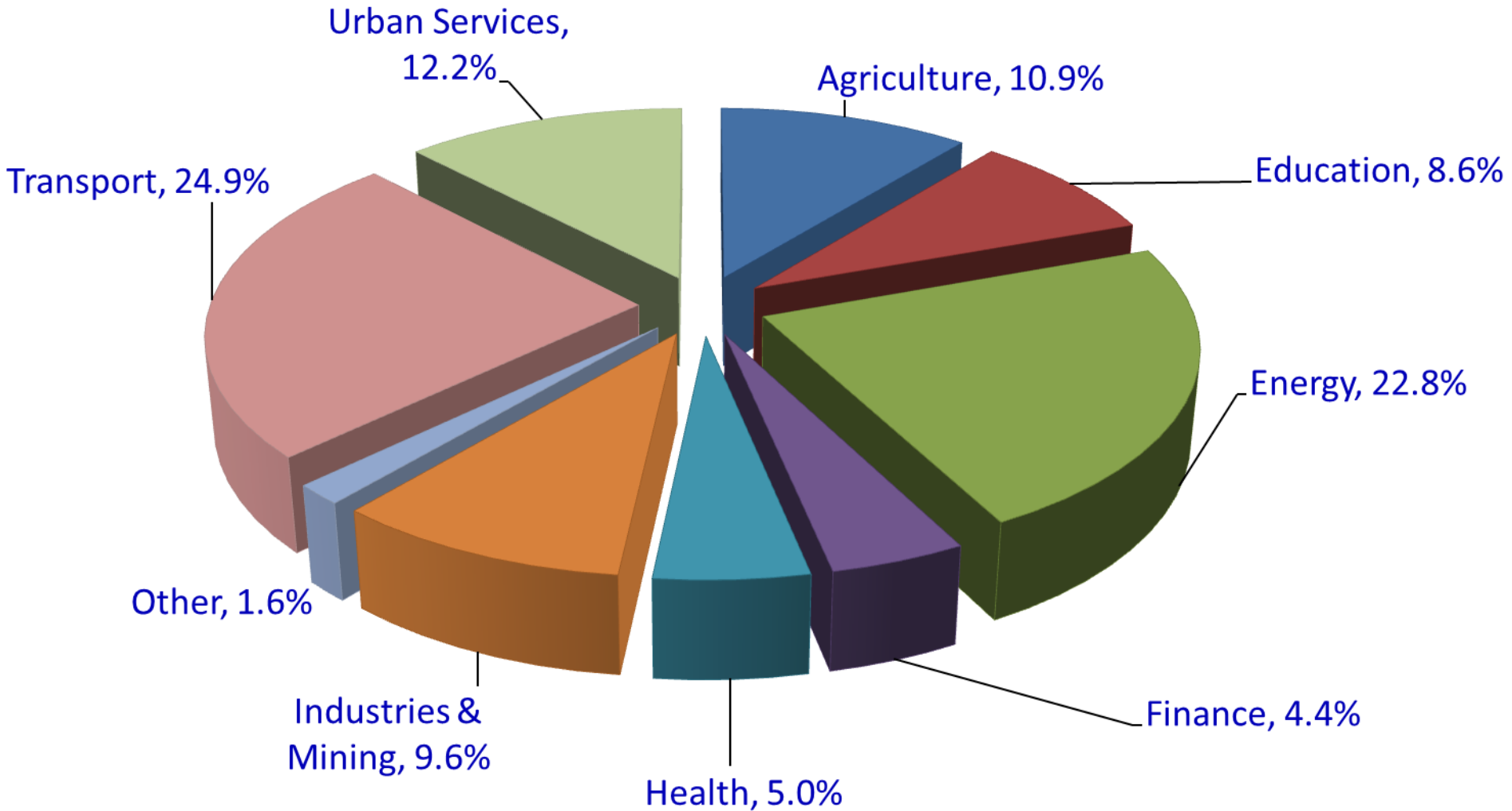
Group Cumulative Approvals: US\$ 86.9 billion

- > Special Assistance US\$ 0.725 billion (0.8%)

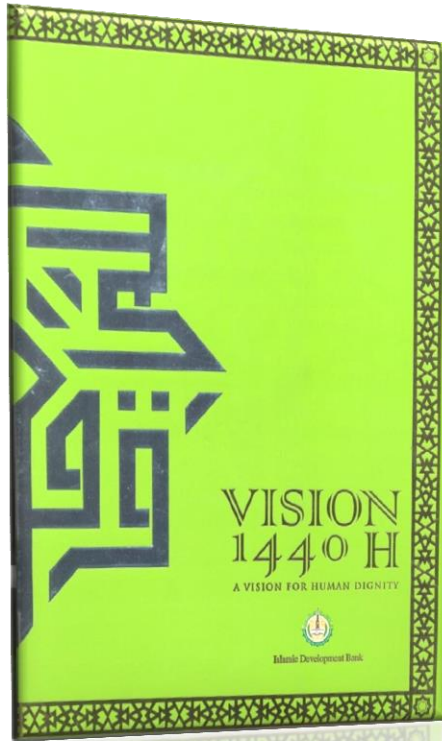
**Yearly Approvals since Bank Inception

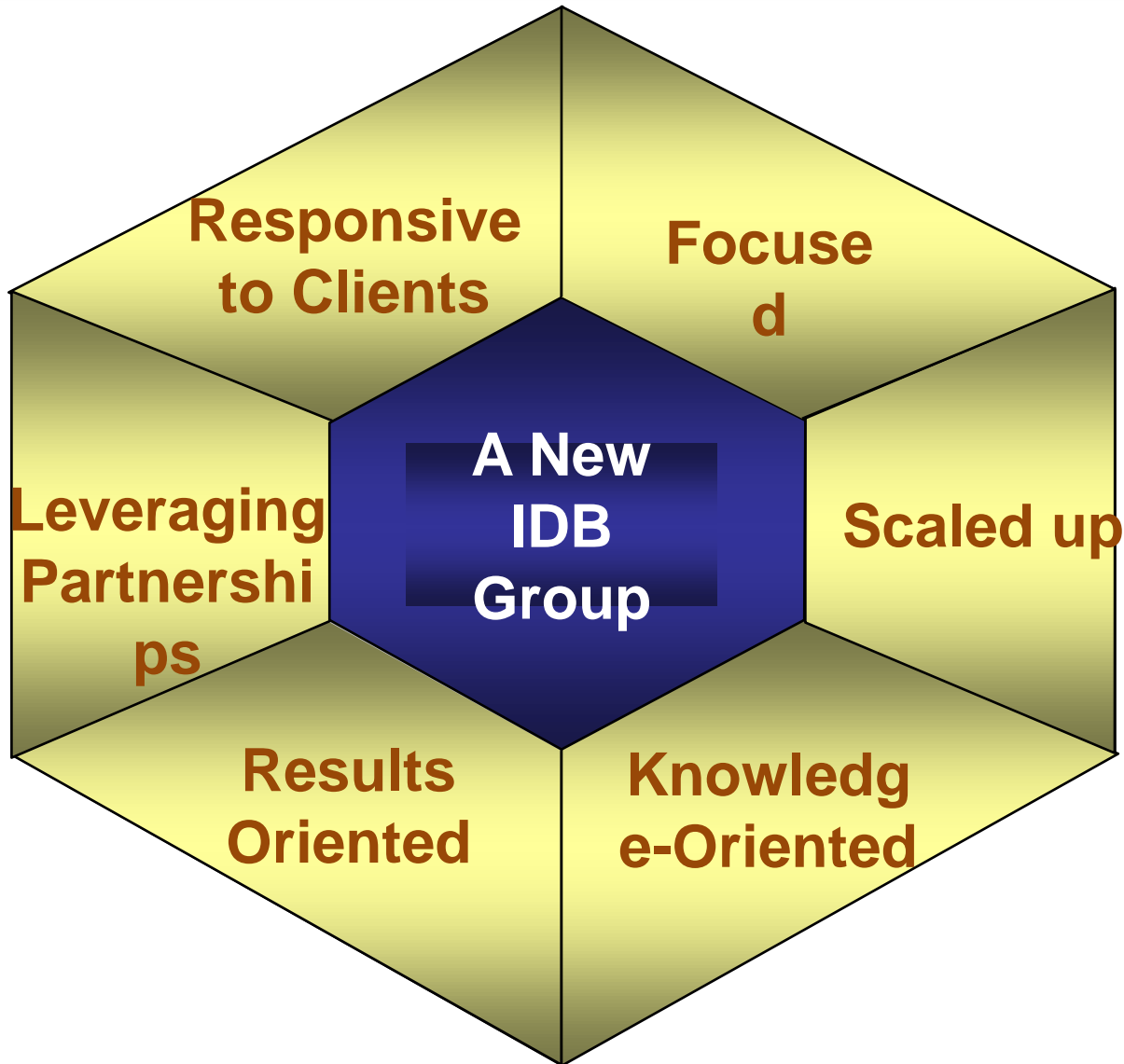
Mission Statement

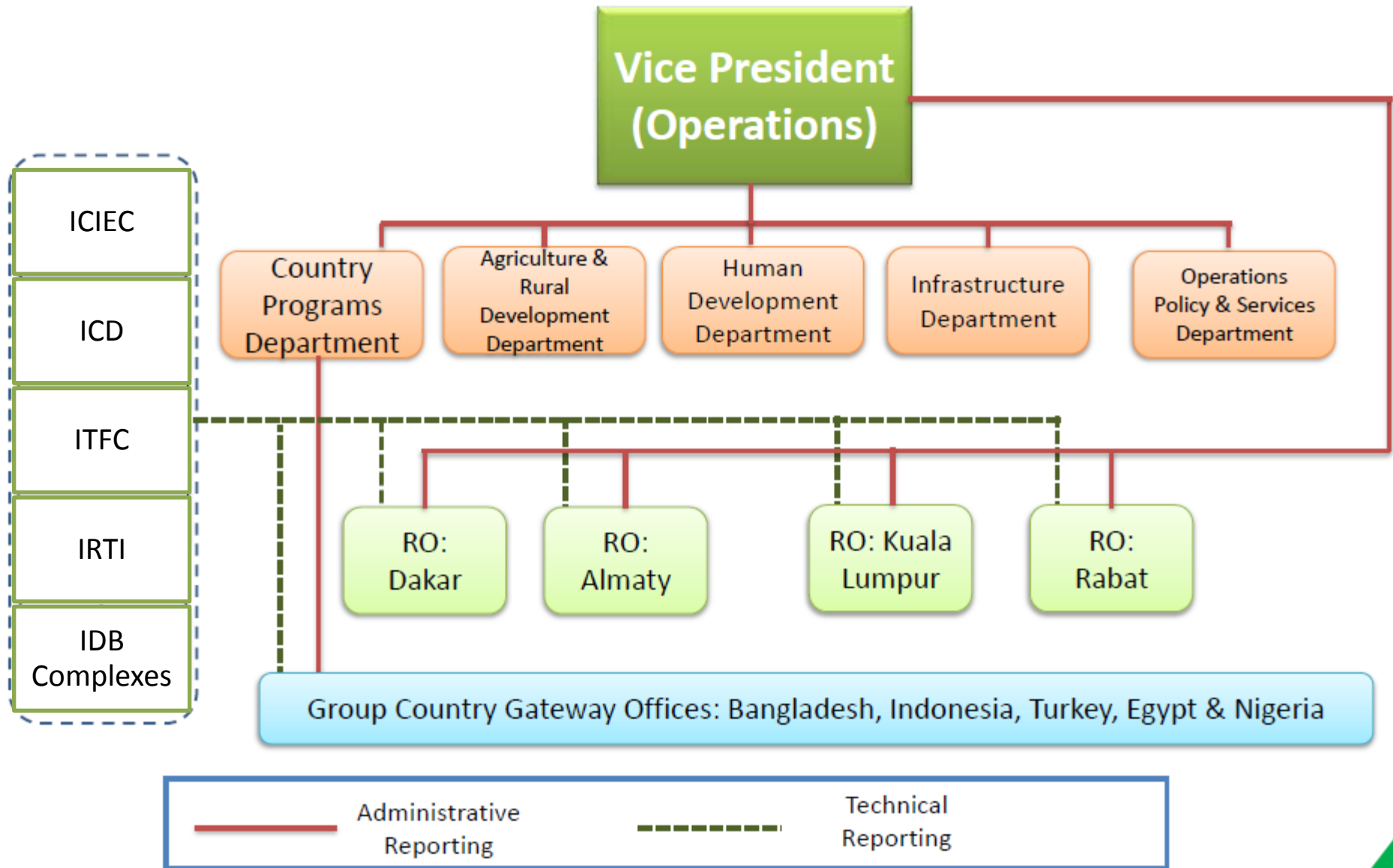
