

Sustainable Cities Africa

The Societé d'Investissments Enérgetiques of Morocco (SIE) initiated the establishment of the Sustainable Cities Africa Fund (Fund), a private equity fund to make investments aimed at reducing the negative environmental and social impacts on African cities. Its investments will contribute to improve the air quality via sustainable city transport, will provide clean energy sources and waste recycling facilities as well as contribute to energy efficiency in the Continent. SIE invited the Islamic Development Bank (IDB) to co-investment in the said Fund along with other investors including Societe Marita Immobiliere (SMI).

In this context, Sustainable Cities Africa side event is organized to debate about the concept of sustainability of African cities. Moreover, SIE will introduce the concept of the Fund and some of the projects in the pipeline.

This event will be co-chaired by H.E Ms. Hakima El Haiti, Minister Delegate in charge of the Environment, Kingdom of Morocco and H.E Dr. Bandar Hajjar, President of the IDB Group.
